

Diabetes Management/Education

1. Locate and schedule an appointment with a Diabetic Educator. See attached instructions, *MFP Finding a Diabetic Educator*.

2. Arrange Home Health Services for participant. Request the nursing home physician to write an order for a “Home Assessment,” specifically requesting diabetic education to be delivered.

- ❖ A “Home Assessment” Visit is a service provided by a Home Health Agency enrolled with HFS. The “Home Assessment” visit does NOT require prior approval. The “Home Assessment” is conducted by a registered nurse from the Home Health Agency who assesses the participant’s condition and determines the level of care needed based on information received from the nursing home physician and information from the home assessment. Request the nurse to provide Diabetic Education and Assessment.
- ❖ TC contacts a Home Health Care Agency that is enrolled with HFS to conduct the initial “Home Assessment Visit” which does NOT require prior approval.
- ❖ The Mitigation Plan/Plan of Care should state that “services are needed to facilitate transition from nursing home to community and prevent the necessity of in-patient long-term care.” Home health nurse to provide diabetic assessment and education.

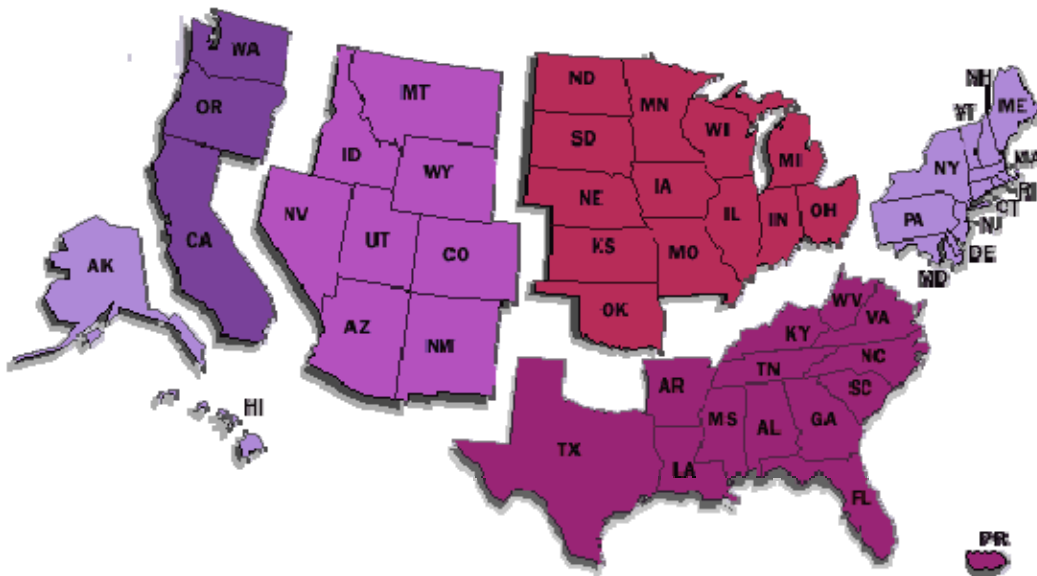
