The purpose of this letter is to request a reasonable accommodation for housing at Lakeview Apartments at 5526 Hyde Park Blvd. Unit 8G Chicago, IL 60657. I have a disability. I believe that the problems causing you to not extend my date for occupancy are related to my disability.

I think the problem happened as a result of my disability because I am unable to occupy the residence immediately due my need for special adaptive equipment and need for assistance with my move.

I think the problem is not likely to happen again because a reasonable accommodation would solve the problem.

The accommodation I request is an extension on the date of occupancy, so I may order and obtain necessary durable medical equipment to accommodate my disability.
